Dear Mr. Sellers,

On December 14, 2009, the Bradley Village Board authorized the hiring of an additional Police Officer. I have been authorized by the Bradley Police & Fire Commission to contact the next candidate on the eligibility list, which is you, to present a conditional offer of employment. As you recall, I first contacted you via telephone on December 15th and scheduled a meeting on December 18th. I then contacted you on December 18th around 4:00 P.M., in which you stated that you had sent me an email that you could not make it due to an emergency at work. I did not receive any such email and advised you that I needed to get this scheduled, due to various additional testing and recruit training scheduled in February 2010. I left a message for you on December 28th and to date have not received a response.

Therefore, this letter is to serve notice that if you do not respond to me by January 5, 2010 at 4:00 P.M. of your intentions regarding employment, I will request the Bradley Police & Fire Commission to strike your name from the eligibility list.
