A motion was made to adopt O-04-22-10 An Ordinance Adopting The Budget For All Corporate Purposes Of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, In Lieu Of The Appropriation Ordinance For The Fiscal Year Commencing On The First Day Of May, 2022 and Ending On The Thirtieth Day Of April, 2023 by Trustee Jordan and seconded by Trustee Vandenhout (5 ayes 0 nays 1 Absent-LeBran) Motion carried

Mayor Watson and Director Romo accepted an award from Government Finance Officers Association as being recognized for budget presentation and transparency and meeting the 14 step categories.

Director Romo gave a pinpoint presentation regarding the 5.6-million-dollar surplus for the Village of Bradley (the Village has never been in a surplus since after the 2019 administration).
