## NEW BUSINESS:

Rolando Iglesias signed the Police Officer Conditional Offer of Employment letter and returned it to the commission. Additionally, the Bradley Police Department notified the commission that both Bryce Crosby and Mohammed Salmon withdrew their names from consideration on the Police Officer Final Eligibility Register.

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer to enter into Executive session per 5ILCS120/2c1. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Glidewell. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried. Executive session was entered at 4:35 p.m. During the executive session, the commission reviewed the background investigation report for Rolando Iglesias. The Executive session was exited at 4:47 p.m. after the review was completed.

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer to revoke the conditional offer of employment made to police officer candidate Rolando Iglesias based on the background investigation results in accordance with Chapter II Section 3 subsection f) and h) of the Rules and Regulation of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners in the Village of Bradley, Illinois. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Glidewell. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

Chairman Golwitzer noted that there were no more eligible candidates on the Police Officer Final Eligibility Register. The new police officer application was launched by Stanard on August 11, 2023 with an application deadline date of September 15, 2023.
