Public Comment: John Beavis spoke against the proposed ordinance due to the fact the Village of Bradley does not have a health department to conduct inspections. Mr. Beavis commented the county can only inspect licensed business, however if the village would enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the county they could inspect those home business. There would be a cost associated with this agreement.

Brook Love spoke in favor of the ordinance, saying she had completed the necessary training and holds a valid food certificate.

The committee reviewed a draft ordinance of the Illinois food handling act (ILCS 625/3.6) which sets forth the rules and regulations for these types of business. A motion by Trustee Allen, 2nd Trustee Balthazor to send the ordinance to the full Board for consideration. Trustee's Redmond, Balthazor, Allen vote aye, no nayes. Motion passed.
