

**Regular Meeting
January 11, 2016**

The regular meeting of the Bradley Village Board was called to order on Monday, January 11, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. at the Bradley Municipal Hall. President Adams presided. Roll call: Trustees Balthazor, Gadbois, Carrico and Watson. Trustee Redmond and Cyr were absent.

POLICE DEPARTMENT- Chief Kufner deferred to Lt. Anderson he noted all Trustees received the December 2015 electronically and read the report.

Lt. Anderson added that in the month of November & December the department collected 12 firearms off the streets.

Holiday Patrol Program - department logged 89 hours on Black Friday. The Holiday hours were November 26th thru December 31st which 89 hrs were on Black Friday and 88 hrs rest of the month. The 36 day period there were:

- 18 retail thefts compared to 35 in 2014
- 1 burglary compared 2 in 2014
- 3 thefts compared to 12 in 2014.

Planning & Zoning Chairman Smith was absent, Ryland Gagnon read the report. The Commission held their meeting on January 5, 2016.

- Petitioner Doug Keast for a Special Use Permit in a M-Industrial District to operate a martial arts school & fitness studio at: 250 S. Kinzie Avenue, Bradley, Illinois voted (8-0) to recommend approval
- Petitioner Joe Greer from Gingerich & Gereaux for a variance from building setback lines within an R-1 residential district of 16 properties in Marquis Meadows. voted (8-0) to recommend approval
- Petitioner Khaleed Shaqildi for a Special Use Permit in a B-2 Commercial District to operate a used car sales at: 350 N. Kennedy Drive, Bradley, Illinois there was a special condition added he would concrete or asphalt the parking lot, this had to be reconvened. voted (8-0) to recommend approval
- Petitioner Thad M. Gleason River North Assisted Living, LLC for a Special Use Permit to operate a health center, assisted living and future independent living facility. Phase I 74,000 square foot building. voted (8-0) to recommend approval

A motion to adopt O-1-16-1 was made by Trustee Balthazor and seconded by Trustee Gadbois. (4 ayes 0 nays 2 absent) Motion carried

2. O-1-16-2 an Ordinance granting a Special Use Permit for the property located at 250 S. Kinzie Avenue, Bradley, Illinois

4. O-1-16-4 an Ordinance granting a Special Use Permit for the property located at 350 N. Kennedy Drive, Bradley, Illinois.

A motion to waive the two readings was made by Trustee Gadbois and seconded by Trustee Watson. (5 ayes 0 nays 2 absent) Mayor voted, Motion carried

A motion to adopt O-1-16-4 was made by Trustee Balthazor and seconded by Trustee Carrico (4 ayes 0 nays 2 absent) Motion carried

5. O-1-16-5 an Ordinance authorizing the disposal of Surplus Property owned by the Village of Bradley.

A motion to waive the two readings was made by Trustee Balthazor and seconded by Trustee Gadbois. (5 ayes 0 nays 2 absent) Mayor voted, Motion carried

A motion to adopt O-1-16-5 was made by Trustee Carrico and seconded by Trustee Gadbois (4 ayes 0 nays 2 absent) Motion carried

INSURANCE & FINANCE

Trustee Gadbois gave the report in Trustee Cyr's absence

- Storm Sewer project for Jonette involving three properties to alleviate the drainage problems, this will be shared by Bradley Bourbonnais Community High School and the Village of Bradley at a cost not to exceed \$12,500.00 for Village of Bradley.
- Purchase of 2016 GMC pickup truck for the Fire Department at a cost of \$41,759.58, which will be replacing a 1997 Suburban and a 1998 Chevy van. The Fire Department is requesting to trade these vehicles at a cost of \$4,000.00 towards the purchase. This would bring the cost down to \$37,759.58 the funds would come out of the Fish Fry and Foreign Fire account.
- Electrical Aggregation Finance Director Pries noted that the rates are now favorable to go out for aggregation. Dynegy Energy presented a 17 month contract at a savings of 8.5% we will be looking into next over the next few months and will be in contact with NIMEC.
- Mayor spoke about the Bourbonnais Parkway this is the new 6000 interchange. Bradley, Bourbonnais, Manteno and County would hire a firm called Ratio for a feasibility study for that intersection the cost is \$5,627.39 to Village of Bradley. We had budgeted \$10,000 for this project we do want get involved in this project so we have input regarding the signage at the interchange.

Trustee Gadbois called an Insurance and Finance Committee meeting on Wednesday, January 27, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. Ehlers will be there to talk about the sewer rate study.

PUBLIC WORKS & PARKS

Trustee Gadbois noted there was a meeting on Monday, January 4, 2016.

Present were Trustee Gadbois, Cyr, Director Bessler and Administrator Powers.

Director Bessler presented the committee with a complete review of the Summerville Court Drainage plan for the next budget year. The cost for the second phase Engineering study would be \$8,000.00.

PARKS

- discussed work for Blatt Park and Lion's Park.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Trustee Watson added a property update regarding the property that the Villages owns at South Street and Washington Avenue. We have gone out for bids, there were no bids. Therefore, there were none for opening. The cost of doing the appraisal and the publication would come before the Finance Committee.

NEW BUSINESS

- Approval of the purchase of a 2016 GMC pickup truck by the Bradley Fire Department
A motion was made by Trustee Gadbois and seconded by Trustee Carrico to approve the purchase of the pickup truck. (4 ayes 0 nays 2 absent) Motion carried

- Electricity Aggregation

Trustee Gadbois noted this was for a 17 month plan. ComEd rates will be posted on our website so our residents could see what the savings would be. The Board concurred to have the Village Administrator signs the RFP and send it out.

- R-1-16-1 a Resolution appropriating funds for maintenance of Street and Highways by the Village of Bradley under the Illinois Highway Code.

A motion was made to adopt R-1-16-1 by Trustee Balthazor and seconded by Trustee Gadbois (4 ayes 0 nays 2 absent) Motion carried

- Bourbonnais Parkway I-57 feasibility study

A motion for our participation in the feasibility study was made by Trustee Gadbois and seconded by Trustee Carrico. (4 ayes 0 nays 2 absent) Motion carried

- Property at the North East corner of Larry Power Road and Rt. 50 approximately 1.5 acres that will be donated to the Village of Bradley. There is a pipeline running through the property that needs to be cleaned up. This is the gateway to our retail area, taxes are \$341.90. This was approved for the Mayor to accept this property.

ADJOURNMENT

A motion was made by Trustee Balthazor and seconded by Trustee Gadbois to adjourn the meeting. The meeting was adjourned at 7:16 p.m. on a unanimous aye vote.
