SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

Chairman Golwitzer called the Special meeting of the Bradley Fire & Police Commission to order on Tuesday, January 25, 2022 at 4:00 p.m.

IN ATTENDANCE:

Chairman Golwitzer, Commissioner Glidewell and Police Chief Barber were in attendance. Secretary Arrington was absent.

NEW BUSINESS:

A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Chairman Golwitzer to promote Anthony Felesena to Police Sergeant. Roll Call (2 Ayes, 0 Nays). Motion Carried.

Chairman Golwitzer performed the swearing in ceremony for Police Sergeant Anthony Felesena.

The updated Police Officer Final Eligibility Register and Initial Eligibility Register were reviewed. A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Chairman Golwitzer to approve the updated Police Officer Registers. Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

Police Chief Barber discussed the status of ongoing background check investigations being performed for candidates on the Final Eligibility Register. The commissioners requested additional information and details be investigated. Police Chief Barber agreed to obtain and provide these details in a future meeting.

The commissioners reviewed the hiring process requirements for certified candidates then determined that the top twenty-seven candidates on the Police Officer Initial Eligibility Register should be interviewed. The interviews will be conducted on February 7th through February 10th. Secretary Arrington was contacted by phone and he agreed to call the candidates to schedule interview times.

With no other business to discuss, a motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to adjourn the meeting. Roll Call (2 Ayes, 0 Nays). Motion Carried. Meeting adjourned at 5:00 p.m.
