Chairman Golwitzer called the Regular meeting of the Bradley Fire & Police Commission to order on Monday, January 4, 2021 at 6:00 p.m.

REVIEW/APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A motion was made by Commissioner Hernandez and seconded by Secretary Arrington to approve the December 7, 2020 Regular Meeting minutes. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE/COMMUNICATION:

The Fire and Police Commission sent a letter dated December 8, 2020 to Chief Kaderabek in regards to Fire Department Captain and Lieutenant ranks. The letter reinforced and clarified that these ranks are not recognized by the Fire and Police Commission. The Village of Bradley Board of Trustees has never approved these ranks nor have any of the firefighters been tested for these ranks. The Fire and Police Commission stressed that the Commission welcomes the opportunity to test the firefighter/paramedics for any rank deemed appropriate by the Village Board in accordance with Illinois statutes. However, the letter also stressed that we must follow the process and legal requirements to award any rank of position within the Village of Bradley Fire Department.

NEW BUSINESS:

Police officer written exam results were received from Stanard and Associates. The scores were reviewed and arranged per highest to lowest score and an initial eligibility register was drafted. A motion was made by Secretary Arrington and seconded by Commissioner Hernandez to approve the Police Officer Initial Eligibility Register. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

Chairman Golwitzer will send an e-mail to all candidates that passed the exam requesting submission of preference point claims. Deadline for submission of the request will be Friday, January 15, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. The requests will be reviewed at the February regular meeting and the Initial Eligibility Register will be updated with the preference points that are awarded by the Commission.

The Polygraph and Psychological reports for Krista Warren were presented and reviewed. The commissioners expressed no concerns with the results.
