NEW BUSINESS:

1. Fire testing to be January 17, 2019 at the Village Hall. Sign in will be at 5:00 p.m. and testing at 6:00 p.m. Chairman Hernandez will call Stanard on November 6, 2018 to confirm the arrangements.
2. Initial results have arrived for the Police candidate's written tests, three failed. Letters will be sent out to applicants to inform them of their passing scores and to request that they submit their request if desired to use their preference points. Letter will be sent to the (3) candidates who failed.
3. The applicants requests for preferential points will be returned by November 16, 2018. There will be a Special meeting on November 26, 2018 to compile the list and post. We will also select the top 15. Teresa will set up and schedule the appointments for the Oral Interviews for the evenings starting on December 3rd through December 6th. We will possibly schedule one candidate for Saturday, December 8, 2018 at 12:30 p.m.
4. Lieutenants testing – the current list will expire on February 11, 2019. Candidate must have 45 to 60 days to study before the test.

A motion was made by Commissioner Golwitzer and seconded by Chairman Hernandez to allow the Chief to schedule Police Lieutenant testing no later than February 1, 2019. Test will include usage of Stanard Assessment Center. Roll call (3 ayes 0 nays) Motion carried.

5. Executive Session reviews are tabled until the December meeting.

The Fire & Police Commission Regular meeting will be postponed from December 3, 2018 until December 12, 2018 at 6:00 p.m.
