SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

Chairman Golwitzer called the Special meeting of the Bradley Fire & Police Commission to order on Friday, February 18, 2022 at 4:30 p.m.

IN ATTENDANCE:

Chairman Golwitzer, Secretary Arrington, Commissioner Glidewell and Police Chief Barber.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

NEW BUSINESS:

Chairman Golwitzer reported that Aaron Juarez, Jordan James and Aaron Cantwell signed the Police Officer Conditional Offer of Employment letters and returned them to the Commission.

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer to enter into Executive session background investigation and polygraph exam results for police office candidates per 5ILCS120/2CL. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Glidewell. Roll Call (3 Ayes, 0 Nays). Motion carried.

Executive session was entered at 4:49 p.m. During the executive session, the Commission reviewed the background investigations completed for police officer candidates Emma Waller, Jordan James, Aaron Cantwell and Aaron Juarez. The Commission also reviewed the polygraph test results for Emma Waller, Jordan James and Aaron Juarez. The Executive session was exited at 5:11 p.m. after the review was completed.

A motion was made by Secretary Arrington to revoke the Conditional Offer of Employment given to Jordan James in accordance with Chapter II Section 3 subsections c) and h) of the Rules and Regulation of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners in the Village of Bradley, Illinois. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Glidewell. Roll Call (3 Ayes, 0 Nays). Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell to revoke the Conditional Offer of Employment given to Aaron Juarez in accordance with Chapter II Section 3 subsections f) and h) of the Rules and Regulation of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners in the Village of Bradley, Illinois. The motion was seconded by Secretary Arrington. Roll Call (3 Ayes, 0 Nays). Motion carried.

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to approve extending Conditional Offers of Employment to two non-certified candidates on the Police Officer Final Eligibility Register. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

The top two police officer candidates on the Police Officer Final Eligibility Register (Lazarus Frerichs and Jacob MacLean) were contacted during the meeting. Each candidate was extended a Conditional Offer of Employment contingent on successfully passing a background investigation, polygraph examination, pre-employment psychological examination, medical examination and proof of Covid-19 vaccination

(requirement for enrollment into Police Academy training). Both Lazarus Frerichs and Jacob MacLean accepted the job offers.

With no other business to discuss, a motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Secretary Arrington to adjourn the meeting. Roll Call (3 Ayes, 0 Nays). Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 5:27 p.m.
