SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

Chairman Golwitzer called the Special meeting of the Bradley Fire & Police Commission to order on Wednesday, February 23, 2022 at 5:00 p.m.

IN ATTENDANCE:

Chairman Golwitzer, Commissioner Glidewell and Police Chief Barber. Secretary Arrington was absent.

NEW BUSINESS:

Chairman Golwitzer reported that Lazarus Frerichs and Jacob MacLean signed the Police Officer Conditional Offer of Employment letters and returned them to the Commission. Additionally, he reported that Emma Waller had withdrawn herself from consideration for the police officer position.

The Commission reviewed the background investigations completed for police officer candidates Lazarus Frerichs and Jacob MacLean. The Commission also reviewed the polygraph test results for Aaron Cantwell. No concerns were noted by the Commissioners.

A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Chairman Golwitzer to approve extending a Conditional Offer of Employment to one non-certified candidate on the Police Officer Final Eligibility Register. Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

The top police officer candidate on the Police Officer Final Eligibility Register (Dalia Montes) was contacted. She was extended a Conditional Offer of Employment contingent on successfully passing a background investigation, polygraph examination, pre-employment psychological examination, medical examination and proof of Covid-19 vaccination (requirement for enrollment into Police Academy training). Dalia Montes accepted the job offer.

With no other business to discuss, a motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to adjourn the meeting. Roll Call (2 Ayes, 0 Nays). Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 5:20 p.m.
