

## Entry-Level Police Officer Hiring Process



### **Bradley Police Department Bradley, Illinois**

The Village of Bradley, Illinois Board of Police Commissioners is accepting applications for the position of police officer with the Bradley Police Department.

**Starting Salary:** \$60,993

**Sworn Police Officers:** 35

**Population:** 15,277 (2018 census)

### **All applicants must meet the following minimum requirements established by the Village of Bradley, Illinois Board of Police Commissioners:**

- U.S. citizenship;
- No felony convictions (Note: a misdemeanor or serious traffic offense may also disqualify applicants from further consideration);
- Possess a valid state-issued driver's license;
- Minimum of 21 years of age -AND- UNDER 35 years of age by the **application deadline date (September 15, 2023)** unless otherwise exempt from such age limitations as provided in 65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-6 of the Fire and Police Commissioner's Act;
- Be a high school graduate or possess a G.E.D. equivalent;
- Must successfully complete an oral interview;
- Must successfully complete a background investigation (applicants will be required to fully disclose all personal matters, to include agreements and sealed files);
- Must successfully complete a psychological evaluation, polygraph examination, and medical physical (including a drug and alcohol screening);
- Must possess a valid P.O.W.E.R. Test card issued within 12 months of the application deadline date (Issued between September 15, 2022 and September 15, 2023);
  - P.O.W.E.R. Test Cards issued by NIPSTA, Triton College, or Joliet Junior College will be accepted.
- **Submit all application documents online by Friday, September 15, 2023 @ 4:00 PM CST;**
- **Review a mandatory police officer candidate orientation presentation prior to submitting application** (you will be required to sign a form acknowledging you reviewed this as part of the application);

- Participate in remote on-line written exam testing starting at **9 AM on Thursday, September 28, 2023 through Saturday, September 30, 2023 at 4 PM.**
