REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

Chairman Golwitzer called the Regular meeting of the Bradley Fire and Police Commission to order on Monday, July 7, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.

IN ATTENDANCE:

Chairman Golwitzer, Secretary Arrington, Commissioner Glidewell and Police Chief Barber.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None.

REVIEW/APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to approve the June 2, 2025, regular meeting minutes; June 16, 2025, June 25, 2025, June 26, 2025 and June 30, 2025 special meeting minutes; and June 2, 2025, June 25, 2025, June 26, 2025 and June 30, 2025 executive session meeting minutes. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE/COMMUNICATION:

The commission received a letter of intent to retire from police officer Lance Devore. His last day of work was July 6, 2025.

APPROVAL OF BILLS:

A motion was made by Secretary Arrington and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to approve a \$325 invoice from Stanard & Associates for lateral police officer rolling application monthly fee prorated for April 2025 (#61343); a \$425 invoice from Stanard & Associates for lateral police officer rolling application monthly fee for June 2025 (#616233); and a \$2,000 invoice from Stanard & Associates for police officer application process (#61600). Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: None.

NEW BUSINESS:

The results of the Police Lieutenant Promotional written exam, assessment center and Police Chief Merit points were reviewed by the commissioners and a new Police Lieutenant Promotional Eligibility Register was established. Commissioner Glidewell made a motion to approve the new Police Lieutenant Promotional Eligibility Register and Chairman Golwitzer seconded the motion. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

Police officer candidate oral interview results were tabulated and a new Police Officer Final Eligibility Register was drafted. A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to approve the Police Officer Final Eligibility Register. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

The commission reviewed the minor corrections recommended for the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Police and Fire Commissioner's Village of Bradley. The proposed revision clarified scoring for the Police Officer Final Eligibility Register (page 11) and corrected oral interview/assessment scoring for Police Sergeant/Lieutenant Promotions (page 17). A motion was made by Secretary Arrington and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to adopt and approve the revision as written. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried. Chairman Golwitzer will ensure a Notice of Publication is published in the Kankakee Daily Journal newspaper. The revised Rules and Regulations shall take effect ten (10) days subsequent to the publication pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-5.

With no other business to discuss, a motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to adjourn the meeting. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:48 p.m.
