SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

Chairman Golwitzer called the Special meeting of the Bradley Fire & Police Commission to order on Monday, July 21, 2025 at 4:30 p.m.

IN ATTENDANCE:

Chairman Golwitzer, Secretary Arrington, Commissioner Glidewell and Police Chief Barber.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

NEW BUSINESS:

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer to enter into executive session to discuss a probationary police officer's performance and to review preliminary background investigation reports for new police officer candidates per 5ILCS120/2c1. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Glidewell. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

A background investigation report was not completed for police officer candidate Marshae Harvey. When contacted, she notified the Bradley Police Department that she was withdrawing her name from future consideration.

Executive session was entered at 4:31 p.m. The executive session was exited at 5:07 p.m. after the discussion of the police officer's performance and the review of the preliminary background reports.

The commission received a letter of resignation from probationary police officer Jerrell White dated July 19, 2025 which was effective immediately. As a result, the request to summarily dismiss the probationary police officer was withdrawn.

Police Chief Barber notified the Commission that the Village President had approved hiring 4 additional police officers. A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Secretary Arrington to approve extending conditional offers of employment to the top 4 candidates on the Police Officer Final Eligibility Register. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

Brodi Winge, Daniel Sanchez, Teagan Shear and Tyler Parsons were contacted and extended a conditional offer of employment contingent on successfully passing a background investigation, polygraph examination and/or voice stress analysis, pre-employment psychological examination, and a medical examination. All four accepted the job offer.

With no other business to discuss, a motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to adjourn the meeting. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 5:31 p.m.
