REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

Chairman Golwitzer called the Regular meeting of the Bradley Fire and Police Commission to order on Monday, August 4, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.

IN ATTENDANCE:

Chairman Golwitzer, Secretary Arrington, Commissioner Glidewell, Police Chief Barber, Fire Chief Spoon

PUBLIC COMMENT: None.

REVIEW/APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Secretary Arrington to approve the July 7, 2025, regular meeting minutes; July 21, 2025 special meeting minutes; and July 21, 2025 executive session meeting minutes. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE/COMMUNICATION:

Police officer candidates Brodi Winge, Daniel Sanchez, Teagan Shear, Tyler Parsons and Matt Lovell submitted their signed letters of acceptance for the conditional offer of employment as a full-time police officer. Subsequently, Tyler Parsons notified the commission that he was withdrawing his application for police officer. In an e-mail response, police officer candidate Guadalupe Cayetano stated that she did not have a POWER card and that she had not scheduled her POWER card test. Lastly, the commission reviewed the response provided to the Illinois State Police who are conducting a background investigation on former police officer candidate Clayton Ritter.

APPROVAL OF BILLS:

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to approve a \$500 invoice from C.O.P.S. and F.I.R.E. for police officer pre-employment psychological exam (#1658); a \$175 invoice from C.O.P.S. and F.I.R.E. for police officer pre-employment polygraph exam (#1265); a \$1,000 invoice from C.O.P.S. and F.I.R.E. for police officer pre-employment psychological exams (#1677); a \$400 invoice from Stanard & Associates for lateral police officer rolling application monthly fee for June 2025 (#61937) and a \$8,791 invoice from Stanard & Associates for police lieutenant promotional process administration (#61902). Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: None.

NEW BUSINESS:

Chairman Golwitzer along with Secretary Arrington and Commissioner Glidewell swore in Brian E. Porter to the position of Deputy Fire Chief.

The Notice of Publication for the revised Rules and Regulations of the Board of Police and Fire Commissioner's Village of Bradley was published in the Kankakee Daily Journal newspaper on July 12,

2025. The revised Rules and Regulations took effect on July 22, 2025 which was ten (10) days subsequent to the publication pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/10-2.1-5.

Chairman Golwitzer noted that two applicants applied for the lateral police officer position in the month of July. A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer to enter into Executive session to review and discuss the available police officer candidates' conditional offer of employment test results along with the police officer lateral candidates' applications per 5ILCS120/2c1. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Glidewell. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

Executive session was entered at 6:15 p.m. The Executive session was exited at 6:43 p.m. after the reviews were completed.

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to authorize Police Chief Barber to initiate background investigations for the two qualified police officer applicants for lateral entry (Alice Balandis, Neil McMahon). Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Secretary Arrington to remove unqualified police officer candidate Guadalupe Cayetano from consideration as a police officer candidate in accordance with Chapter II Section 3 subsection a) of the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners in the Village of Bradley, Illinois. Cayetano does not have a POWER card as required for the position. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

A motion was made by Secretary Arrington and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to approve the 2024 Annual report. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

With no other business to discuss, a motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Secretary Arrington to adjourn the meeting. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:13 p.m.
