SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES

Chairman Golwitzer called the Special meeting of the Bradley Fire & Police Commission to order on Thursday, August 21, 2025 at 4:30 p.m.

IN ATTENDANCE:

Chairman Golwitzer, Secretary Arrington, Commissioner Glidewell and Police Chief Barber.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

NEW BUSINESS:

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer to enter into executive session to review medical exam results, psychological evaluations, polygraph and/or voice stress analysis results for entry level police officer candidates and to review the background investigations for two lateral police officer candidates per 5ILCS120/2c1. The motion was seconded by Secretary Arrington. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

Executive session was entered at 4:34 p.m. The executive session was exited at 5:10 p.m. after the reviews were completed.

A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Secretary Arrington to approve swearing in Brodi Winge, Daniel Sanchez, Teagan Shear and Matthew Lovell at the next Village of Bradley Board meeting based on the satisfactory fulfillment of the conditional offer of employment requirements. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer to remove Neil McMahon from consideration of employment as a police officer candidate for lateral entry in accordance with Chapter II Section 3 subsection f) and subsection h) of the Rules and Regulation of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners in the Village of Bradley, Illinois. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Glidewell. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

A motion was made by Secretary Arrington to remove Alice Balandis from consideration of employment as a police officer candidate for lateral entry in accordance with Chapter II Section 3 subsection f) and subsection h) of the Rules and Regulation of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners in the Village of Bradley, Illinois. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Glidewell. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

The commissioners reviewed the proposal from Stanard and Associates for entry level police officer applications and written exams. A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to approve the proposal with no fees for the applicants. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried. Chairman Golwitzer will sign and return the proposal to Stanard and Associates.

It was agreed that the application deadline date would be November 21, 2025 to allow sufficient time for the village to advertise the position opening in order to draw a better quality candidate pool.

With no other business to discuss, a motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to adjourn the meeting. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 5:41 p.m.
