REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

Chairman Golwitzer called the Regular meeting of the Bradley Fire and Police Commission to order on Tuesday, September 2, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.

IN ATTENDANCE:

Chairman Golwitzer, Commissioner Glidewell and Police Chief Barber. Secretary Arrington was absent.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None.

REVIEW/APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Chairman Golwitzer to approve the August 4, 2025, regular meeting minutes; August 21, 2025 special meeting minutes; and August 4, 2025 and August 21, 2025 executive session meeting minutes. Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE/COMMUNICATION:

The commission received a background information request from the Kankakee Community College Police Department for a former employee who had signed an authorization for release of personal information. Chairman Golwitzer provided the requested information to the department.

APPROVAL OF BILLS:

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to approve a \$500 invoice from C.O.P.S. and F.I.R.E. for police officer pre-employment psychological exam (#1739); a \$175 invoice from C.O.P.S. and F.I.R.E. for police officer pre-employment polygraph exam (#1686); a \$1,000 invoice from C.O.P.S. and F.I.R.E. for police officer pre-employment psychological exams (#1693); a \$350 invoice from C.O.P.S. and F.I.R.E. for police officer pre-employment polygraph exam (#1680); a \$450 invoice from Stanard & Associates for lateral police officer rolling application monthly fee for July 2025 (#62207); a \$2,517 invoice from Riverside Workforce Health for police officers pre-employment physical exams (#132086-00); and a \$879 invoice from Riverside Workforce Health for police officer pre-employment physical exam (#132012-00). Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: None.

NEW BUSINESS:

Chairman Golwitzer stated that the entry level police officer application had been launched by Stanard and Associates on the applytoserve.com website. The application deadline was extended to 12/1/2025 per the request of Police Chief Barber to allow additional time to advertise the position at Illinois colleges. No candidates have applied for the position to date. The online written exam will be taken between 12/10/2025 and 12/12/2025.

Chairman Golwitzer noted that three applicants applied for the lateral police officer position in the month of August. A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer to enter into Executive session to review

and discuss the police officer lateral candidates' applications per 5ILCS120/2c1. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Glidewell. Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

Executive session was entered at 6:06 p.m. The Executive session was exited at 6:15 p.m. after the reviews were completed.

A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Chairman Golwitzer to remove unqualified police officer candidate for lateral entry, Rolando Iglesias, from consideration as a lateral police officer candidate in accordance with Chapter II Section 3 subsection a) of the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners in the Village of Bradley, Illinois. Iglesias does not meet the minimum 2 year experience requirement for the position. Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to authorize Police Chief Barber to initiate background investigations for the two qualified police officer applicants for lateral entry (Daniel Herrera, Jacob Howard). Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

The executive session meeting minutes were reviewed. A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Chairman Golwitzer to keep the minutes sealed. Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

With no other business to discuss, a motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to adjourn the meeting. Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:20 p.m.
