REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

Chairman Golwitzer called the Regular meeting of the Bradley Fire and Police Commission to order on Monday, October 6, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.

IN ATTENDANCE:

Chairman Golwitzer, Commissioner Glidewell, Secretary Arrington and Police Chief Barber.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None.

REVIEW/APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Chairman Golwitzer to approve the September 2, 2025, regular meeting minutes and September 2, 2025 executive session meeting minutes. Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Secretary Arrington abstained. Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE/COMMUNICATION:

The commission received a letter of resignation from police officer James Knapp. His last day of work is October 21, 2025.

APPROVAL OF BILLS:

A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Secretary Arrington to approve a \$475 invoice from Stanard & Associates for lateral police officer rolling application monthly fee for August 2025 (#62573) and a \$35 invoice from Riverside Workforce Health for a police officer pre-employment test (#132223-00). Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: None.

NEW BUSINESS:

Chairman Golwitzer stated that 10 applicants have applied for the entry level police officer position. The application deadline is 12/1/2025. The online written exam will be taken between 12/10/2025 and 12/12/2025.

Chairman Golwitzer noted that one applicants applied for the lateral police officer position in the month of September. A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer to enter into Executive session to review and discuss the police officer lateral candidate application for September and background investigation results for the two August applicants per 5ILCS120/2c1. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Glidewell. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

Executive session was entered at 6:06 p.m. The Executive session was exited at 6:35 p.m. after the reviews were completed.

A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Secretary Arrington to remove unqualified police officer candidate for lateral entry, Daniel Herrera, from consideration as a lateral police officer candidate in accordance with Chapter II Section 3 subsection h) of the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners in the Village of Bradley, Illinois. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Secretary Arrington to remove unqualified police officer candidate for lateral entry, Jacob Howard, from consideration as a lateral police officer candidate in accordance with Chapter II Section 3 subsection e), f), and h) of the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners in the Village of Bradley, Illinois. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Secretary Arrington to authorize Police Chief Barber to initiate a background investigation for the qualified police officer applicant for lateral entry (Jessica Cotugno). Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

With no other business to discuss, a motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to adjourn the meeting. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:38 p.m.
