

BRADLEY FIRE & POLICE COMMISSION  
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

Chairman Golwitzer called the Regular meeting of the Bradley Fire and Police Commission to order on Monday, January 5, 2026, at 6:00 p.m.

IN ATTENDANCE:

Chairman Golwitzer, Secretary Arrington, Deputy Fire Chief Porter and Police Chief Barber.  
Commissioner Glidewell was absent.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None.

REVIEW/APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A motion was made by Secretary Arrington and seconded by Chairman Golwitzer to approve the December 1, 2025, regular meeting minutes and December 1, 2025 executive session meeting minutes. Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE/COMMUNICATION:

The commissioners discussed feedback received from firefighter candidate Austin Coffman in regard to his removal from the Firefighter Final Eligibility Register.

APPROVAL OF BILLS:

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Secretary Arrington to approve a \$400 invoice from Stanard & Associates for lateral police officer rolling application monthly fee for November 2025 (#63411) and a \$2,000 invoice from Stanard & Associates for the police officer application process (#63413). Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: None.

NEW BUSINESS:

Chairman Golwitzer stated that 1 applicant has applied for the entry level firefighter position. The application deadline is 2/6/2026. The online written exam will be taken between 2/18/2026 and 2/20/2026.

The commissioners discussed Fire Chief Spoon's request to add language to the Rules and Regulations allowing Prehospital Registered Nurses (PHRNs) to apply for the entry level firefighter position. Per the Fire Chief, PHRNs are essentially the equivalent of a paramedic (EMT-P), as they function the same in the field. He stated that this could potentially increase the number of applicants for the position. Chairman Golwitzer stated that the commission would need some type of documentation validating the equivalency of a PHRN to an EMT-P. Deputy Fire Chief Porter stated that he would work on obtaining that documentation.

Police officer written exam results were received from Stanard and Associates. The scores were reviewed and arranged per highest to lowest score and an initial eligibility register was drafted. A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Secretary Arrington to approve the Police Officer Initial Eligibility Register. Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

Chairman Golwitzer will send an e-mail to all candidates that passed the exam requesting submission of preference point claims. Deadline for submission of the request will be Friday, January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2026 at 11:59 p.m. The requests will be reviewed at a Special Meeting to be held on Monday, January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2026 and the Initial Eligibility Register will be updated at that time with the preference points that are awarded by the commission.

Oral interviews will be conducted with all candidates on the Police Officer Initial Eligibility Register. The interviews will be scheduled with the candidates by Secretary Arrington to be completed on January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2026; February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2026; and February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2026.

Executive session was not entered. Chairman Golwitzer noted that one applicant applied for the lateral police officer position in the month of December 2025. That candidate, William Wilson, has no experience as a police officer which is a preliminary requirement for the position. A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Secretary Arrington to remove unqualified police officer candidate William Wilson from consideration as a lateral police officer candidate in accordance with Chapter II Section 3 subsection a) of the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners in the Village of Bradley, Illinois. Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

With no other business to discuss, a motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Secretary Arrington to adjourn the meeting. Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:40 p.m.
