

BRADLEY FIRE & POLICE COMMISSION
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

COMMISSIONERS

Chairman Golwitzer called the Regular meeting of the Bradley Fire and Police Commission to order on Monday, February 2, 2026, at 6:00 p.m.

IN ATTENDANCE:

Chairman Golwitzer, Secretary Arrington, Deputy Fire Chief Porter and Fire Chief Spoon. There currently is an open position for Commissioner.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None.

REVIEW/APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A motion was made by Secretary Arrington and seconded by Chairman Golwitzer to approve the January 5, 2026, regular meeting minutes; the January 19, 2026, and January 29, 2026, special meeting minutes and the January 29, 2026 executive session meeting minutes. Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

CORRESPONDENCE/COMMUNICATION:

Commissioner Greg Glidewell resigned from the Fire & Police Commission effective January 25, 2026. Police officer candidate Steven Petrenko sent an e-mail inquiring about his written exam results as he had not been notified by Stanard. Chairman Golwitzer replied to the inquiry with an apology and his results. Lastly, Chairman Golwitzer provided feedback to the commission about Tyler Kingston's law enforcement certificate question which came up during his oral interview. His certificate was from the Cook County Sheriff's Office Department of Corrections Academy. It does not meet the Minimum Standards Basic Law Enforcement Training Course as provided in the Illinois Police Act.

APPROVAL OF BILLS:

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Secretary Arrington to approve a \$425 invoice from Stanard & Associates for lateral police officer rolling application monthly fee for December 2025 (#63566). Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Discussed Fire Chief Spoon's request to revise the EMT application requirements in the Rules and Regulations. Deputy Fire Chief Porter provided a letter from Al Ponton, the EMS System Manager for Riverside Emergency Medical Services which states that a Prehospital Registered Nurse (PHRN), Prehospital Advanced Practiced Registered Nurse (PHAPRN) and a Prehospital Physician Assistant (PHAP) are authorized to function at the paramedic scope of practice in the EMS System. After discussion, Chairman Golwitzer agreed to draft a revision of the Rules and Regulation to make this change. The draft will be reviewed at the next regular meeting for approval.

NEW BUSINESS:

Chairman Golwitzer stated that 4 applicants have applied for the entry level firefighter position. The application deadline is 2/6/2026. The online written exam will be taken between 2/18/2026 and 2/20/2026.

Executive session was not entered. Chairman Golwitzer noted that no applicants applied for the lateral police officer position in the month of January 2025.

With no other business to discuss, a motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Secretary Arrington to adjourn the meeting. Roll call (2 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:23 p.m.
