

BRADLEY FIRE & POLICE COMMISSION
REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

Chairman Golwitzer called the Regular meeting of the Bradley Fire & Police Commission to order on Monday, March 7, 2022, at 6:00 p.m.

IN ATTENDANCE:

Chairman Golwitzer, Secretary Arrington, Commissioner Glidewell and Police Chief Barber.

REVIEW/APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Secretary Arrington to approve the February 10, 2022 Regular meeting minutes, the February 15, February 18 and February 23, 2022 Special meeting minutes, and the February 10 and February 18, 2022 Executive session meeting minutes. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENT: None

CORRESPONDENCE/COMMUNICATION:

Dalia Montes signed the Firefighter Conditional Offer of Employment letter and returned it to the Commission. Chief Kaderabek and Cody Reinbold notified Chairman Golwitzer that Cody had failed the medical fitness test. The Commission is waiting for the official report from the physician before taking any action.

APPROVAL OF BILLS:

The commissioners reviewed the invoices from Physicians Immediate Care for \$205, from Conrad Polygraph for \$800 and from First Responders Wellness Center for \$525. A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Chairman Golwitzer to approve these bills. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: None

NEW BUSINESS:

The commissioners reviewed the status of the Police Lieutenant Promotional testing preparation. The written exam is scheduled for March 14, 2022. The assessment center is scheduled for March 24, 2022 at River Valley Christian Fellowship Church.

The Commission reviewed the psychological and medical reports for police officer candidate Aaron Cantwell. They also reviewed the polygraph results for police officer candidates Jacob MacLean and Dalia Montes. The commissioners expressed no concerns with the results.

Chief Kaderabek notified the Commission that the Village President had approved hiring 4 additional firefighters. A motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Secretary Arrington to

approve extending Conditional Offers of Employment to the top 4 candidates on the Firefighter Final Eligibility Register. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried.

Michelle Francoeur, David Adkins and Marcis Dubois were contacted and extended a Conditional Offer of Employment contingent on successfully passing a background investigation, polygraph examination, pre-employment psychological examination, medical examination and the Bradley Fire Department Firefighter Physical Agility Exam. All three accepted the job offer.

Kyle Haemker was contacted and extended a Conditional Offer of Employment contingent on successfully passing a background investigation. He had previously completed all other Conditional Offer of Employment requirements within the last year. He accepted the job offer.

With no further business to discuss, a motion was made by Commissioner Glidewell and seconded by Secretary Arrington to adjourn the meeting. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:11 p.m.
