Trustee Watson had questions regarding Broadway stripping it has failed and it seems to be a hazard. Administrator Wojnarowski stated it is in the plans to resurface Broadway in the 20/20 Fiscal year, until then we will use the County to re-strip that will be done this summer.

Trustee Watson had a question on the sale tax referendum. Administrator stated that this was not a consensus of all the Trustee to have a tax referendum.

Trustee Watson wanted to compliment the Police Department on the Memorial services held on Memorial Day at Legion's Park.
