Chairman Golwitzer called the Regular meeting of the Bradley Fire & Police Commission to order on Monday, June 5, 2023, at 6:00 p.m.

REVIEW/APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Firefighter candidate Lucas Schejbal submitted a signed letter of acceptance for the conditional offer of employment as a full-time firefighter.

APPROVAL OF BILLS:

A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to approve invoice #1005 from SelectMed for a firefighter pre-employment medical exam for \$330.00 and invoice #5596 from Conrad Polygraph for a firefighter pre-employment polygraph exam for \$180.00. NEW BUSINESS:

Firefighter candidate James Johnson was sworn in as a full-time firefighter/paramedic for the Village of Bradley.

The commissioners reviewed and discussed the firefighter application minimum qualifications and the minimum written test score requirements. It was agreed that no changes were needed to the application and that the minimum written test score for passing would remain at 70%.

The commissioners reviewed the proposal from Stanard and Associates for firefighter applications and written exams. A motion was made by Chairman Golwitzer and seconded by Commissioner Glidewell to approve the proposal. Roll call (3 ayes, 0 nays). Motion carried. Chairman Golwitzer will sign and return the proposal to Stanard and Associates.
