**PUBLIC WORKS** Director Bessler gave his report for the month of June 2015. ## REPORT OF SPECIAL COMMITTEES

Planning & Zoning Committee – Chairman Smith stated that the Committee met on July 7, 2015 he noted Trustee Redmond had some questions concerning Blanchette Auto Repair and the property on Fairview. There was suppose to be no sales of autos on the Blanchette property and the Fairview property was suppose to be a Day Care Facility both will be looked into.

## New Business:

1. Village of Bradley application for an amendment to chapter 60 (Zoning), Article 5 (Administration) Section 369 (Authorized Variations) to add metal buildings as an authorized variance in B-1 and B-2 business districts.

Approved for recommendation to the Board by an 8 to 0 vote.

Village of Bradley application for an amendment to chapter 60 (Zoning) Article 5
(Business District) and Article 6 (Industrial District) Sections 152(b)
(B-1 Commercial District). 153(2) (8-2 Commercial District), and 179(2)
(M-Industrial District) to add a medical marijuana dispensary as a special use within said zoning districts.

Approved for recommendation to the Board by an 8 to 0 vote.

Approved for recommendation to the Board by an 8 to 0 vote. Contingent upon the Board Approval of the change to the Zoning Board to the Metal Buildings.

A motion was made to approve O-7-15-4 by Trustee Gadbois and seconded by Trustee Cyr (6 ayes 0 nays) Motion carried

O-7-15-5 an Ordinance granting a Variance from Metal Building restrictions for the Property Located at 1806 N. State Rte 50, Bourbonnais, IL (1<sup>st</sup> reading)

A motion to waive the two readings was made by Trustee Gadbois and seconded by Trustee Balthazor. (7 ayes 0 nays) Mayor voted

A motion was made to approve O-7-15-5 by Trustee Redmond and seconded by Trustee Gadbois (6 ayes 0 nays) Motion carried

Trustee Gadbois wanted to let everyone know at the Monday, July 6, 2015 meeting that Director Bessler gave an update of all the Parks.

#### **INSURANCE & FINANCE**

Trustee Cyr stated that Mr. John Miller with Ehlers was present we will have a chance in December to refinance our GO Sewer Bonds. In August an Ordinance will be presented to show the perimeters of the refinancing.
