**SUBJECT: USE AND SALE OF CANNABIS IN THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY UNDER THE CANNABIS REGULATION AND TAX ACT**

On June 25, 2019, Illinois enacted the Illinois Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act ("the Act"). The Act allows for the recreation sale and use of cannabis in the State of Illinois commencing January 1, 2020. The Act also provides that local municipalities may not prohibit the use of cannabis in a manner that conflicts with state law. The Act does not permit the public consumption of cannabis.

Local municipalities are authorized to "allow, prohibit, or significantly limit" the sale of recreational cannabis within its borders. The Village of Bradley Board of Trustees will hold public hearings on the following dates in the Village Hall Council Chambers located at 147 S. Michigan Ave. Bradley, IL 60915-2299.

At the hearings, the Village Board will accept comment, testimony, and advocacy on whether or not and in what manner the Village of Bradley should allow cannabis dispensaries. In addition, the Board will accept comment on whether the Village of Bradley should allow on site consumption of cannabis in licensed cannabis businesses as provided under the Act. Comments shall be limited to 3 minutes per individual unless notice is provided to the Village Deputy Clerk. Requests for time extensions and questions may be made to: Teresa M.
