

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, will hold a public hearing on July 8, 2020 at 5:30 pm at the Village of Bradley Administrative Building, 147 S. Michigan Avenue, Bradley, Illinois 60915. At said hearing, the Corporate Authorities will provide any and all interested parties with an opportunity to express their views on certain proposed Downstate Small Business Stabilization applications funded by Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funds.

On or about July 8, 2020 the Village of Bradley intends to apply to the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for a series of grants from the State CDBG program. This program is funded by Title 1 of the federal Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended.
