**AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE INTERSECTIONS OF WEST BROOKMONT,  
BISHOP COURT AND LENNINGTON CIRCLE (NW), IN THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY,  
AS STOP INTERSECTIONS**

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 11-80-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-80-2) authorizes the Corporate Authorities of the Village to regulate the use of the streets and other municipal property under the Village's jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 11-208(6) of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-208(6)) further authorizes the Corporate Authorities of the Village, through the exercise of the Village's police powers, to designate any intersection under the Village's jurisdiction as a stop intersection and require all vehicles to stop at one or more entrances to such intersections; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has jurisdiction over the intersection of West Brookmont,, Bishop Court and Lennington Circle (NW) in the Village of Bradley; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is necessary for public health, safety, and welfare to require vehicles to stop before entering the West Brookmont, Bishop Court and Lennington Circle (NW) Intersection from the North, South, East OR West bound direction; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

**SECTION 2.** The Corporate Authorities hereby declare that the West Brookmont, Bishop Court and Lennington Circle (NW) Intersection is and shall be a stop intersection. It is and shall hereinafter be unlawful for any vehicle to enter West Brookmont, Bishop Court and Lennington Circle (NW) Intersection from the North, South, East OR West bound direction without first stopping as required by law.

**SECTION 3.** The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to erect or cause the erection of such signs as are necessary to give reasonable notice of the stopping requirements imposed by this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Ordinance that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

**SECTION 5.** That all ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

**SECTION 6.** That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

**SECTION 7.** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
