**ORDINANCE NO. O-07-22-07**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 40 (SOLID WASTE), SECTION 40-54  
(SPECIAL COLLECTION) OF THE BRADLEY VILLAGE CODE**

---

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village previously enacted Chapter 40 (Solid Waste) of the Bradley Village Code to regulate, *inter alia*, the collection of waste within the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 40-54 of the Bradley Village Code, all licensed haulers operating in the Village are required to provide special collection services to Village residents and businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is necessary, expedient, and in the best interests of the Village and its citizens for the Village to also offer special collection services to its residents in addition to the licensed haulers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is necessary, expedient, and in the best interests of the Village and its citizens to amend Chapter 40 (Solid Waste), Section 40-54 (Special Collection) of the Village code as set forth in this Ordinance.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

**SECTION 2.** That Chapter 40 (Solid Waste) of the Bradley Village Code is hereby amended to include the following new provisions:

**Sec. 40-54. - Special collection.**

- (a) As used in this section, the term "special collection" includes pickup of furniture, white goods, and other miscellaneous items.
- (b) All licensed haulers must offer special collection services within the village, and shall file their special collection policies, as amended from time to time, including all rates and charges for such special collection with the village's community development department.
- (c) In addition, the village shall provide special collection services as follows:

- (1) Village special collection services shall be available to all residential dwelling located within the Village with two (2) or fewer dwelling units.
- (2) Village special collection services shall not be available to any commercial or business institution, nor to any residential dwelling with more than two (2) dwelling units.
- (3) Village special collection services will be regularly scheduled for the second and fourth Thursday of each month, excluding holidays, but such collection may be conducted on other dates by appointment depending on availability.
- (4) Any residential dwelling property owner with two (2) or fewer dwelling units desiring the use of Village special collection services must schedule a pickup through the Village's Public Works department and the service fee will be added to the property owner's sewer bill. The service fee shall be as provided in the village fee schedule in section 18-1.

**SECTION 3.** In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Ordinance that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

**SECTION 4.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

**SECTION 5.** The Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

**SECTION 6.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.



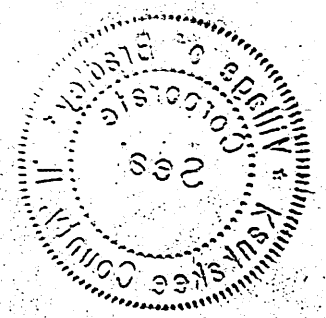
