**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 18 (FEES AND OTHER CHARGES) OF THE
BRADLEY VILLAGE CODE**

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1-2-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1-2-1), the Corporate Authorities of the Village are authorized to pass all ordinances and make all rules and regulations proper or necessary, to carry into effect the powers granted to the Village, with such fines or penalties as may be deemed proper; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 11-60-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-60-1), the Corporate Authorities of the Village are authorized to fix the amount, terms, and manner of issuing and revoking licenses within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village previously exercised the foregoing authority by enacting, *inter alia*, Chapter 18 (Fees and other Charges), Section 18-1 (Fees) of the Village code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is necessary, expedient, and in the best interests of the Village and its citizens to amend said Section 18-1 as set forth in this Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. Chapter 18 (Fees and other Charges), Section 18-1 (Fees) is hereby amended, in relevant part, to read as follows:

In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Ordinance that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

SECTION 5. That all ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 6. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 7. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

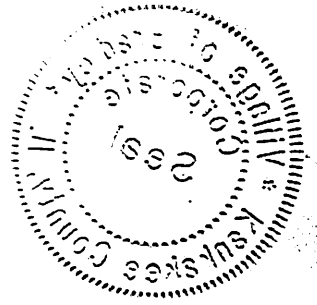

Sec. 56-40. Abatement by village.

If the person served with the notice specified in section 56-39 does not abate the nuisance within two days after such notice, the health officer or the superintendent of streets and alleys, or a designee, may proceed to abate such nuisance, and the expense therefrom shall be charged to and paid by the owner or occupant. The reasonable costs to the village in setting up, maintaining, and operating the required equipment as well as the wages paid to the operators and overhead paid on the equipment and personnel shall be included in the calculation of the expense or costs which shall be charged to and paid by the owner or occupant as provided in the village fee schedule in section 18-1.
