ORDINANCE NO. O-4-21-4

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING EMPLOYEE SALARIES AND REPEALING  
CONFLICTING ORDINANCES**

---

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1: COMPENSATION OF EXEMPT EMPLOYEES**

- A. The Village employees identified on “Attachment A,” which is attached hereto and fully incorporated herein, are exempt employees that are not subject to the minimum wage and overtime requirements of existing Illinois and Federal Law. Beginning on May 1, 2021, the employees identified on Attachment A shall be entitled to receive an annual salary that falls within the base salary ranges set out in Attachment A.

**SECTION 2: REPEAL OF PRIOR ORDINANCES**

- A. All existing ordinances of the Village of Bradley are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinances.

**SECTION 3:** In the event that any provision or provisions, or portion or portions of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions or portions of this Ordinance that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions.

**SECTION 4:** That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

**SECTION 5:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


