A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BIDS IN CONNECTION WITH THE YORKTOWN DOG PARK FENCE PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt resolutions and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, on or around April 2, 2022, the Village published an advertisement for bids for the Yorktown Dog Park Fence Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Village opened and reviewed all bids received in relation to the Project on April 14, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that Shoop & Sons was the lowest responsible bidder for the respective Project; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is necessary, expedient, and in the best interests of the Village and its citizens to accept the bid from Shoop & Sons in the total amount of twenty-nine thousand, nine-hundred, eighty-six and 55/100 (29,986.55) for the Yorktown Dog Park Fence Project (a copy of the Shoop & Sons bid is attached hereto as Exhibit A and fully incorporated herein); and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. The Corporate Authorities of the Village hereby find and declare that the bid received by Shoop & Sons for the Yorktown Dog Park Fence Project Bid in connection with the Project, a copy which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and fully incorporated herein, is fair, reasonable, and acceptable to the Village and hereby awards said contract to Shoop & Sons, for the amount of twenty-nine thousand, nine-hundred, eighty-six and 55/100 (29,986.55)

SECTION 3. The Corporate Authorities of the Village hereby authorize and direct the Public Works Director to take any actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution, which is to accept the bid for the Project and to award the vendor the contract bid.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Resolution shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Resolution that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

SECTION 5. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 6. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution in pamphlet form.

SECTION 7. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

The Village is seeking to establish a space to be created as a Dog Park, located next to the Retention Pond at Yorktown and Brassie. Bids for fence material were solicited and opened on 14 April 2022. In total, 4 bids were received and evaluated. The apparent low bid, from Shoop & Sons (from Decatur, IL) for \$29,986.55 is recommended for approval.
