WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt resolutions and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, on or around April 17, 2024, the Village published an advertisement for bids for the Partial Roof Replacement at Village Hall (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Village opened and reviewed all bids received in relation to the Project on May 3, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that Langlois Roofing Inc., (Langlois) was the lowest responsible bidder of the respective project; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is necessary, expedient, and in the best interests of the Village and its citizens to accept the bid from Langlois Roofing Inc., in the total amount of forty five thousand nine hundred sixty and 00/100 (\$45,960.00) for the Partial Roof Replacement at Village Hall (a copy of the bid tabulations is attached hereto as Exhibit A and fully incorporated herein); and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made part hereof.

SECTION 2. The Corporate Authorities of the Village hereby find and declare that the bid received by Langlois Roofing Inc. for the Partial Roof Replacement at Village Hall, a copy which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein, is fair, reasonable and acceptable to the Village and hereby awards said contract to Langlois Roofing. Inc. for the amount of forty-five thousand nine hundred sixty and 00/100 (\$45,960.00).

SECTION 3. The Corporate Authorities of the Village hereby authorize and direct the Village President to take any actions necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution, which is to accept the bid for the Project and to award the vendor the contract bid.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Resolution shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of

the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Resolution that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 6. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution in pamphlet form.

SECTION 7. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.



Dear Mr. Williams,

At your request, our office solicited bids compliant with 30 ILCS 500, The Illinois Procurement Code, for the Bradley Village Hall Partial Roof Replacement. The solicitation was publicly advertised with bids received and publicly opened at the Bradley Public Works Department on May 3, 2024 at 10:00AM local time.

A total of five responsive bids were received from Anthony Roofing out of Aurora, DCG Roofing Solutions out of Melrose Park, Langlois Roofing out of Kankakee, Top Roofing Incorporated out of Wheaton, and Tori Construction LLC out of Alsip. Per the enclosed bid tabulation, base bids ranged from \$45,960 to \$154,481.88. The bid average was \$82,656.78 with our estimate coming in lower at \$71,757.00. A difference of approximately 15% from the average.

We have reviewed the submitted bids and recommend that the Village of Bradley award the project to Langlois Roofing in the amount of \$45,960.00.
