A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE SCHUYLER AVENUE AND EAST BROADWAY ENHANCEMENT PROJECT TO THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR CONSIDERATION UNDER THE ILLINOIS TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt resolutions and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Village supports enhancement of its transportation systems through the installation and improvement of pedestrian and recreation facilities, and desires to improve the quality of life for residents of the Village of Bradley; and

WHEREAS, the Village Staff, under the direction of the Village President and Board of Trustees, have prepared an application for submission to the Illinois Department of Transportation (“IDOT”) for consideration under the Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program (“ITEP”) regarding the proposed Schuyler Avenue and East Broadway project (the “Project”).

WHEREAS, the Project entails the construction of a ten foot (10’) wide shared path, decorative street lighting, and landscaping, as well as associated improvements, at a total estimated cost of one million nine hundred ninety-one thousand nine hundred fifty and 00/100 dollars (\$1,991,950.00), with the Village’s anticipated match of the cost being four hundred thirteen thousand eight hundred and 00/100 dollars (\$413,800.00); and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees have determined that submission of the aforementioned application for the Project to IDOT for consideration under ITEP is in the best interests of the citizens of the Village of Bradley.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. Support of Submission: Application regarding the Schuyler Avenue and East Broadway Project for Consideration under ITEP. The Village board fully supports, approves, and hereby authorizes the submission of the application regarding the Project, as described in the preamble to this Resolution and at the costs set forth above, to IDOT for consideration under ITEP.

SECTION 3. Funding for the Schuyler Avenue and East Broadway Project. The Village commits to provide all funds necessary to complete the Project, as described in the preamble to this Resolution, provided that this commitment is contingent upon IDOT approving the Village’s ITEP

application for said project. In passing this resolution, the Village Board understands that ITEP is a reimbursement program that reimburses up to eighty percent (80%) of all engineering and construction costs and up to fifty percent (50%) of all right of way acquisition costs associated with approved projects.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Resolution shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Resolution that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

SECTION 5. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 6. The Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution in pamphlet form.

SECTION 7. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


