## A RESOLUTION APPROVING A LOCAL PUBLIC AGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY AND THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt resolutions and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 2-3-8 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/2-3-8), the Corporate Authorities of the Village are authorized to enter into contracts that serve the legitimate purposes of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village supports efforts to enhance existing state and local roads, as well as other parts of the existing transportation system, through the installation of pedestrian and recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Village has negotiated a Local Public Agency Agreement for Federal Participation (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u> and fully incorporated herein, with the Illinois Department of Transportation ("IDOT"); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Agreement is to jointly propose certain improvements, including without limitation a multi-use path, pedestrian crosswalks and signals, and storm sewer improvements, along North Kinzie Avenue in the Village of Bradley between Ken Hays Drive and Larry Power Road (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have reviewed the Agreement and have determined that the terms, conditions, and provisions thereof are fair, reasonable, and acceptable to the Village, and further that it is in the best interests of the Village and its citizens for the Village to enter into said Agreement with IDOT.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. The Corporate Authorities of the Village hereby find and declare that the terms, conditions, and provisions of the Agreement (Exhibit A) are fair, reasonable, and acceptable to the Village and further that the same is hereby approved in form and substance. Therefore, the Corporate Authorities hereby authorize and direct the Village President to execute, and the Village Clerk to attest, the Agreement and further to take any and all additional

actions, including without limitation the execution of any and all documents, necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution, which is to enter into the Agreement with IDOT.

SECTION 3. The Corporate Authorities hereby commit to provide all funds necessary to complete the Project as outlined in the Agreement, provided that this commitment is contingent upon IDOT approving the Village's ITEP application for said Project. In passing this resolution, the Village Board understands that ITEP is a reimbursement program that reimburses up to eighty percent (80%) of all engineering and construction costs associated with approved projects.

**SECTION 4.** In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Resolution shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Resolution that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

**SECTION 5.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

**SECTION 6.** The Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution in pamphlet form.

**SECTION 7.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
