**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF BS&A SOFTWARE FOR THE FINANCE
AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENTS**

WHEREAS, the Village of Bradley is not a home rule municipality within Article VII, Section 6A of the Illinois Constitution and, pursuant to the powers granted to it under 65 ILCS 5/1-1 et seq.; and,

WHEREAS, Fire and EMS Services are a critical component of the Life safety within the Village of Bradley; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Bradley (“the Village”) wishes to authorize the purchase and a new Advanced Life Support Ambulance; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds that this Resolution protects and promotes the public welfare, safety and health of the Citizens of Bradley.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. PURCHASE THE AUTHORIZED

The Fire Chief is authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Alexis for the Purchase of an Advanced Life Support Vehicle, the total cost authorized for project purchase shall not exceed \$137,000. This purchase was approved by the Public Safety Committee on December 11, 2023.

SECTION 2. The Corporate Authorities hereby waive, by an affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the trustees presently holding office, any and all competitive bidding requirements as might otherwise be applicable to the purchases authorized by this Resolution.

SECTION 3. In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Resolution shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Resolution that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 5. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution in pamphlet form.

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There was a Public Safety Committee meeting earlier this evening where the fire department requested \$137,000 to purchase a demo ambulance from Alexis Fire Apparatus. The cost of the ambulance is \$125,000 and has 27,864 miles on it. The additional funds are for wrapping the ambulance, installation of radios, MDT mounting and power stretcher mount. The ambulance will arrive here ready to go.

The 2009 Ford ambulance had been sent in for service as the head gaskets were leaking. It was found to have both heads warped and would need a new/rebuilt motor. The cost of the motor is \$23,000 plus labor. The vehicle is not worth that much after it is repaired, and it is coming up on 15 years of service.

The ambulance is beyond its serviceable life. We had contacted ARV who we have an ambulance on order to try and expediate the build, but they were unable to as not all of the components are at their facility as yet. We contacted numerous vendors and feel this is the best value with a reasonably quick delivery date of early January.

The cost of the ambulance is \$125,000 and has 27,864 miles on it. The additional funds are for wrapping the ambulance to match the current fleet, installation of radios, MDT mounting and power stretcher mount. The ambulance will arrive here ready to go.

We will trade in this ambulance which will help defray the cost, the vendor has given us a trade in value of \$10,300 which we feel is a fair offer.
