RESOLUTION NO. R-2-21-2

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF POLICE BODY WORN CAMERAS

WHEREAS, the Village of Bradley is not a home rule municipality within Article VII, Section 6A of the Illinois Constitution and, pursuant to the powers granted to it under 65 ILCS 5/1-1 et seq.; and,

WHEREAS, police body worn cameras act as a police reform and state mandate; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of Bradley ("the Village") wishes to authorize the purchase and installation of new security cameras; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds that this Resolution protects and promotes the public welfare, safety, health and morals;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. BODY WORN CAMERA PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION AUTHORIZED

The Police Chief is authorized and directed to execute an agreement with Advanced Computer Specialists, Williams Communications for the purchase and installation of police body worn cameras. The Police Chief shall further be authorized and directed to execute any related or supplemental documents, including approval of scopes of work, project timelines or revisions thereto, proposals, or related documents, and is further authorized to serve as project manager and to execute all documents relating to installation.

SECTION 2. The Corporate Authorities hereby waive, by an affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of the trustees presently holding office, any and all competitive bidding requirements as might otherwise be applicable to the purchases authorized by this Resolution.

SECTION 3. In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Resolution shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Resolution that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 5. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution in pamphlet form.

SECTION 6. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

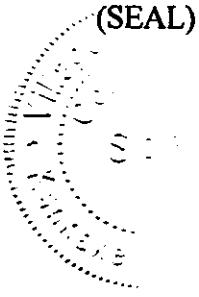

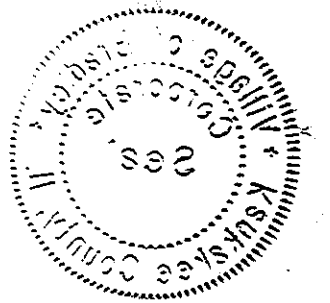

Brief Summary:

The Police Department is seeking to purchase and install up to 38 body worn cameras, one for each officer to meet state mandate, and to include installation of all necessary compatible equipment into the squad cars. The purchase has not been budgeted in the fiscal year budget amount and needs amended. The aggregate price for the body worn cameras shall not exceed ninety thousand, and 00/100 dollars (\$90,000.00). The install price shall not exceed ten thousand, and 00/100 dollars (\$10,000.00). The Chief further authorized and directed to take any action and sign any document necessary to accomplish the purchase of the body worn cameras and installation practices authorized by this Resolution.

The Village of Bradley Police Department is requesting a waiver to bypass the competitive bidding process. Due to the technical components of the equipment being compatible with our existing Milestone Video software for storage and server space, this item would likely qualify as a sole source provider. If we were to go with another camera system, the Village would need to purchase additional storage hardware which would increase the price of the project exponentially. The Village reached out to two authorized Panasonic dealers and our current IT vendor Advanced Computer Specialist was the cheaper option for the cameras. The installation will be handled by our current car install vendor Williams Communications.
