A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL PRIMARY ELECTION HELD WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, ON THE SEVENTEENTH (17TH) DAY OF MARCH, 2020

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**WHEREAS**, a general primary election was conducted in the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, on the seventeenth (17<sup>th</sup>) day of March, 2020, for the purpose, *inter alia*, of holding a referendum on a question of public policy, to wit: “Shall the Village of Bradley, for the purpose of granting property tax relief or for expenditure on public infrastructure or both, as well as for the purpose of supporting municipal operations, impose a Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailer's Occupation Tax, Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax and Non-Home Rule Municipal Use Tax (commonly referred to as “Municipal Sales Taxes”) each at a rate of 1% in accordance with and subject to provisions of Sections 8-11-1.3, 8-11-1.4 and 8-11-1.5 of the Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.3, 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.4 and 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.5)?” (the “Election”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Election was called, the votes were cast, and the Kankakee County Clerk has canvassed the votes, all in accordance with applicable law; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kankakee County Clerk has declared and proclaimed the results of the Election; and

**WHEREAS**, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley desire to proclaim and declare the results of the Election so that said results are included in the permanent records of the Village of Bradley.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Resolution are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

**SECTION 2. Conduct of General Primary Election.** A general primary election (the “Election”) was held pursuant to and in accordance with all applicable laws in the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois on March 17, 2020. Thereafter, on April 1, 2020, the Kankakee County Clerk canvassed the votes cast in the Election and declared and proclaimed that the total number of ballots cast was 2,539.

**SECTION 3. Proclamation of Election of Village President.** The Kankakee County Clerk has canvassed the votes cast in the Election on the following question of public policy:

“Shall the Village of Bradley, for the purpose of granting property tax relief or for expenditure on public infrastructure or both, as well as for the purpose of supporting municipal operations, impose a Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailer's

Occupation Tax, Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax and Non-Home Rule Municipal Use Tax (commonly referred to as "Municipal Sales Taxes") each at a rate of 1% in accordance with and subject to provisions of Sections 8-11-1.3, 8-11-1.4 and 8-11-1.5 of the Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.3, 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.4 and 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.5)?”

The Kankakee County Clerk has declared that 1,725 votes were cast in favor of said proposition, 814 votes were cast against said proposition, and as a result said proposition passed. The Corporate Authorities of the Village hereby announce and declare that said proposition was duly passed on March 17, 2020, in accordance with applicable law.

**SECTION 4. Certification by Kankakee County Clerk.** On April 1, 2020, the Kankakee County Clerk certified the aforementioned election results and issued an “Abstract of Votes” concerning the same. Copies of the Kankakee County Clerk’s “Certificate of Canvass Results” and “Abstract of Votes” for the Election are attached hereto as Group Exhibit A and fully incorporated herein by reference.

**SECTION 5.** In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Resolution shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Resolution that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

**SECTION 6.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Resolution, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

**SECTION 7.** The Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Resolution in pamphlet form.

**SECTION 8.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
