

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ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY
AND
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(VILLAGE SQUARE)

WHEREAS, the Village of Bradley (“Village”) is an Illinois municipal corporation, organized and existing pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-209, the Village is authorized and empowered to enter into agreements with private entities to enforce traffic regulations upon privately owned parking lots falling within the jurisdiction of the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village recognizes the need to enforce parking regulations upon the Village Square parking lot;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, State of Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Recitals Incorporated. The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth.

Section 2. Execution of Agreement. The Village President and Village Clerk are hereby authorized to sign, execute and deliver the agreement known as the Parking Lot Agreement, as attached.

Section 3. Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances and Resolutions. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Resolution. All existing resolutions of the Village of Bradley are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.

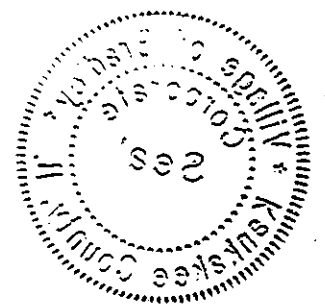
