AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 (ADMINISTRATION), ARTICLE II (BOARD OF TRUSTEES) OF THE BRADLEY VILLAGE CODE TO PROVIDE FOR BOARD INAUGURATIONS AT THE FIRST REGULAR OR SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES IN THE MONTH OF JUNE FOLLOWING ANY ELECTION.

ORDINANCE NO. 0-10-20-5

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2 (ADMINISTRATION), ARTICLE II (BOARD OF TRUSTEES) OF THE BRADLEY VILLAGE CODE TO PROVIDE FOR BOARD INAUGURATIONS AT THE FIRST REGULAR OR SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES IN THE MONTH OF JUNE FOLLOWING ANY ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Section 3.1-10-15 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/3.1-10-15) authorizes the Corporate Authorities of the Village to fix the date for inauguration of newly elected officers of the Village by Ordinance, provided that said date may not be later than the first regular or special meeting of the Corporate Authorities in the month of June following their election; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village and its Citizens to enact this Ordinance to fix the date for inauguration of newly elected officers of the Village upon the first regular or special meeting of the Corporate Authorities in the month of June following their election.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. Chapter 2 (Administration), Article II (Board of Trustees), Division 1 (Generally), Section 2-23 (Creation; Election; Term) of the Bradley Village Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-23. - Creation; election; term.

There shall be a board of trustees which shall consist of six members, each of whom shall be elected to the office for a four-year term, according to the method provided by statute. Each member of the board of trustees shall be inaugurated, and their respective term in office shall commence, at the first regular or special meeting of the Corporate Authorities of the Village in the month of June following their election.

SECTION 3. Chapter 2 (Administration), Article II (Board of Trustees), Division 2 (President), Section 2-75 (Creation of office; Election; Term) of the Bradley Village Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-75. - Creation of office; election; term.

There shall be a village president who shall be elected for a term of four years, and he or she shall be the village president of the board of trustees, as is provided by state statute. The village president shall be inaugurated, and his or her term in office shall commence, at the first regular or special meeting of the Corporate Authorities of the Village in the month of June following his or her election.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Ordinance that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

SECTION 5. That all ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 6. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 7. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
