AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 52 (TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES), ARTICLE IV (STOPPING, STANDING, PARKING, AND COMPLIANCE), SECTION 52-131 (MANNER OF PARKING) OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-80-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-80-2) and Section 11-208 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/11-208), the Village is authorized to regulate the parking and standing of vehicles on Village streets; and

WHEREAS, the Village previously exercised this authority by enacting, *inter alia*, Section 52-131 of the Village Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, expedient, and in the best interests of the Village and its citizens to amend Section 52-131 of the Village Code as forth in this Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> That Chapter 52 (Traffic and Vehicles), Article IV (Stopping, Standing, Parking, and Compliance), Section 52-131 (Manner of Parking) of the Village Code is hereby amended and replaced, as follows:

Sec. 52-131. Manner of parking.

- (a) Except as otherwise provided in subpart (b), below, it shall be unlawful to park any vehicle with the left side of the vehicle next to the curb.
- (b) Vehicles may be parked with the left side of the vehicle next to the curb in the following circumstances, and no others:
 - (1) Vehicles parked on one-way streets.
 - (2) Vehicles displaying registration plates or decals issued to (i) a person with disabilities, as defined by 625 ILCS 5/1-159.1, or (ii) a disabled veteran, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/3-609, but only in front of residential structures with a village-permitted handicapped parking sign erected pursuant to Section 52-167 of this code.

(c) It shall be unlawful to stand or park any vehicle on a street in any orientation other than parallel with the curb with the two closest wheels of the vehicle within 12 inches of the regularly established curbline, except that vehicles standing or parked on streets that have been marked by the Village for angle parking shall be parked at the angle to the curb indicated by such marks.

SECTION 3. In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Ordinance that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clauses.


<u>SECTION 4.</u> That all ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 6. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


