ORDINANCE NO. O-5-14-1

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2012 INTERNATIONAL SWIMMING POOL AND SPA CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, Kankakee County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Code of Ordinances Amended. Division 9 ("International Pool and Spa Code") shall be added to Article III ("Technical Codes") of Chapter 10 ("Buildings and Building Regulations") of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Bradley, and shall read as follows:

Sec. 10-271-275 Reserved.

Division 9. International Pool and Spa Code

Sec. 10-276 Adoption of code.

The International Pool and Spa Code 2012, as published by the International Code Council be, and hereby is adopted as the pool and spa code of the village for purposes of providing minimum standards to safeguard life or limb, health, property and public welfare by regulating and controlling the design, construction, installation, quality of materials, location and maintenance or use of aquatic vessels. Each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions, and terms of said Code are hereby referred to and adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this division with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in section 10-277.

Sec. 10-277. Amendments, additions and changes.

The pool and spa code as adopted in section 10-276 shall be amended by making the following changes and additions:

All references within the International Swimming Pool and Spa Code to the "International Plumbing Code" shall be stricken and replaced with "Illinois Plumbing Code, as amended".

All references within the International Swimming Pool and Spa Code to the "International Residential Code" shall be stricken and replaced with "International Residential Code, as amended".

All references within the International Swimming Pool and Spa Code to the "International Building Code" shall be stricken and replaced with "International Building Code, as amended".

Section 101.1: Title.

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These regulations shall be known as the International Swimming Pool and Spa Code of <u>the Village of Bradley</u> hereinafter referred to as "this Code".

Section 105.6 Fees

105.6.2 Fee schedule. The fees for all work shall be as indicated in <u>Section 18-1</u> of the Village of Bradley Code of Ordinances. the following-schedule:

Delete Section 105.6.3 Fee Refunds in its entirety.

Section 107 Violations

That Section 107.4 shall read as follows:

107.4 Violation Penalties. Any person who shall violate a provision of this code or shall fail to comply with any of the requirements thereof or who shall erect, install, alter or repair an aquatic vessel in violation of the approved construction documents or directive of the code official, or of a permit or certificate issued under the provisions of this code, shall be <u>subject to penalties as prescribed by</u> <u>law. guilty of a [SPECIFY OFFENSE], punishable by a fine of not more than</u> [AMOUNT] dollars or by imprisonment not exceeding [NUMBER OF DAYS], or both such fine and imprisonment. Each day that a violation continues after due notice has been served shall be deemed a separate offense.

That Section 107.5 shall read as follows:

107.5 Stop Work Orders. Upon notice from the code official, work on any system that is being done contrary to the provisions of this code or in a dangerous or unsafe manner shall immediately cease. Such notice shall be in writing and shall be given to the owner of the property, or to the owner's agent, or to the person doing the work. The notice shall state the conditions under which work is authorized to resume. Where an emergency exists, the code official shall not be required to give a written notice prior to stopping the work. Any person who

shall continue any work in or about the structure after having been served with a stop work order, except such work as that person is directed to perform to remove a violation or unsafe condition, shall be <u>subject to penalties as prescribed by law.</u> liable to a fine of not less than [AMOUNT] dollars or more than [AMOUNT] dollars.

Section 302 Electrical, Plumbing, Mechanical and Fuel Gas Requirements

That Section 302.5 shall read as follows:

302.5 Backflow Protection. Water supplies for aquatic vessels shall be protected against backflow in accordance with the <u>Illinois Plumbing Code</u>, as amended <u>International Plumbing Code or the International Residential Code</u>, as applicable in accordance with Section 102.7.1.

That Section 302.6 shall read as follows:

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302.6 Wastewater discharge. Where wastewater from aquatic vessels, backwash from filters and water from deck drains discharge to the building drainage system, such installation shall be in accordance with the <u>Illinois Plumbing Code</u>, as <u>amended</u> International Plumbing Code or the International Residential Code, as applicable in accordance with Section 102.7.1.

Section 304 Flood Hazard Areas

That Section 304.2 shall read as follows:

304.2 Determination of impacts based on location. Aquatic vessels located in flood hazard areas established by the International Building Code, as amended, or the International Residential Code, as amended, or Chapter 16 of the Village of Bradley Code of Ordinances, shall comply with Section 304.2.1 or 304.2.2.

Exception: Aquatic vessels located in riverine flood hazard areas that are outside of designated floodways and aquatic vessels located in flood hazard areas where the source of flooding is tides, storm surges, or coastal storms.

Section 305 Barrier Requirements

Delete Exception [2] of Section 305.1 in its entirety.

Section 307 General Design

That Section 307.9 shall read as follows:

307.9 Accessibility. An accessible route to the public aquatic vessel shall be provided in accordance with the International Building Code, as amended, and the Illinois Accessibility Code, as amended. Accessibility within the public aquatic vessel shall be provided as required by the accessible recreational facilities provisions of the International Building Code, as amended, and the Illinois Accessibility Code, as amended. Accessibility for aquatic vessels accessory to detached one- and two-family dwellings and townhouses not more than three stories in height shall be provided where required by the International Residential Code, as amended, and the Illinois Accessibility Code, as amended.

Sec. 10-278-279 Reserved.

<u>Section 2</u>. <u>Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances</u>. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance. Section 10-9 ("Outdoor Swimming Pools") of the Code of Ordinances of the Village of Bradley, and all other existing ordinances that may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance of the Village of Bradley, are hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Effective Date</u>. The Clerk of the Village of Bradley shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause it to be published in pamphlet form and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and publication in pamphlet form as so certified.
