AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4 (ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES) OF THE BRADLEY VILLAGE CODE TO CREATE A NEW CLASS B3 LIQUOR LICENSE

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-1 of the Illinois Liquor Control Act of 1934 (235 ILCS 5/4-1) (the "Act") grants the Corporate Authorities of the Village the power to determine the number, kind, and classification of local liquor licenses within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have previously exercised the authority granted by Section 4-1 of the Act, establishing the number, kind, and classifications of all local liquor licenses permitted within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village and its citizens to amend the provisions of its liquor licensing ordinances, along with other related provisions of the Village Code, as set forth in this Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. Chapter 4 (Alcoholic Beverages), Article III (Licenses), Division 1 (In General), Section 4-68 (Classifications and Amount of Fees) is hereby amended to add the <u>underlined</u> text, as follows:

Sec. 4-68. Classifications and amounts of fees.

Licenses shall be and are hereby divided into classes, with fees for such licenses as follows:

* * *

Class B3 license (tavern with package sales, beer and wine only, and entertainment; full kitchen required). Issued to authorize (i) the retail sale of alcoholic liquors for consumption on the licensed premises of a tavern, as well as (ii) the retail sale of beer and wine only in its original packages, unopened, for consumption off the licensed premises. A full menu, including entrees and appropriate side dishes and a fully staffed and operational kitchen shall be required at all times liquor sales are being conducted or until 10:00 p.m., as the case may be, provided that the licensee shall only be required to open the kitchen on six (6) days out of every week. This class shall permit entertainment in the licensed premises. All entertainment must be confined within the fully

enclosed building on the licensed premises. Sound from the entertainment must not be audible outside the enclosed building of the licensed premises. The full amount of the license fees for such class B3 license shall be as set forth in section 4-77 of this chapter.

SECTION 3. Chapter 4 (Alcoholic Beverages), Article III (Licenses), Division 1 (In General), Section 4-77 (Number of Licenses, Annual License Fees, and Automatic License Reduction) is hereby amended to add the <u>underlined</u> text, as follows:

Sec. 4-77. Number of licenses, annual license fees, and automatic license reduction.

(a) The number of license in each classification, as well as the annual fee for said license, shall be as follows:

Class	Maximum Number of Available Licenses in Class	Annual Fee	

Class B3 license (tavern with package sales, beer and wine only, and entertainment; full kitchen required)	1	<u>\$1,500.00</u>

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Ordinance that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clauses or clauses.

<u>SECTION 5.</u> That all ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 6. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 7. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
