

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 54 OF THE VILLAGE OF
BRADLEY
(SPECIFIC POLLUTANT LIMITATIONS)**

WHEREAS, it is necessary that re-evaluation of industrial discharge limitations be updated; and

WHEREAS, amendments to the present ordinance are necessary to reflect the prescribed mandates and to effectuate compliance

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Bradley Village President and Board of Trustees the following:

Section 1. That Section 54-174 (e)(8) of the ordinance entitled "Use of Public Sewers" be deleted in its entirety and the following be added thereto:

(e)(8) Discharges from each separate discharge of a User, as measured under the provisions of this ordinance, shall not contain in excess of the following concentrations based upon instantaneous maximum allowable discharge.

Compliance with the provisions of this Section shall be required no later than 365 days following the effective date of ordinance.

Section 2. Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance. All existing ordinances of the Village of Bradley are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. The Clerk of the Village of Bradley shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause it to be published in pamphlet form, and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and publication in pamphlet form as so certified.


