# ORDINANCE NO. 0-08-24-05

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 56 (VEGETATION), ARTICLE II (WEEDS), OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 11-20-7 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-20-7) the Village is authorized to regulate the cutting and removal of neglected weeds, grass, trees, and bushes; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary, expedient, and in the best interests of the Village and its citizens to amend Sections of the Village Code as forth in this Ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1.** The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. That Chapter 56 (Vegetation), Article II (Weeds), Section 56-39 (Notice to Owner or Occupant Requiring Abatement) of the Village Code is hereby amended as follows, with stricken text being removed and additional text being in bold and underlined:

### Sec. 56-39. – Notice to Owner or Occupant Requiring Abatement.

It shall be the duty of the health officer Code Enforcement Officer or the superintendent of streets and alleys, or a designee, to serve or cause to be served a notice upon the owner or occupant of any such premises on which weeds or plants are permitted to grow in violation of the provisions of this division, and to demand the abatement of the nuisance within two seven days. Where a A property owner cannot be found, or otherwise is to be served with notice by mail, then alternatively additionally, notice to abate a violation of this section may shall be given by posting a sign in a conspicuous place near the main entrance of a structure or on the property. In either event, the The text of the notice shall contain a reference to the provision of this code violated and may contain such other information respecting the nature of the violation as the health officer Code Enforcement Officer deems advisable. It shall be unlawful for anyone to deface, tamper with, or remove the "Notice to Abate" sign from the property where it is posted unless authorized by the health officer Code Enforcement Officer or the superintendent of streets and alleys, or a designee.

**SECTION 3.** That Chapter 56 (Vegetation), Article II (Weeds), Section 56-40 (Abatement by Village) of the Village Code is hereby amended as follows, with stricken text being removed and additional text being in bold and underlined:

#### Section 56-40. – Abatement by Village.

If the person served with the notice specified in Section 56-39 does not abate the nuisance within two seven days after such notice, the health officer Code Enforcement Officer or the superintendent of the streets and alleys, or a designee, may proceed to abate such nuisance, and the expense therefrom shall be charged to and paid by the owner or occupant. The reasonable costs to the village in setting up, maintaining, and operating the required equipment as well as the wages paid to the operators and overhead paid on the equipment and personnel shall be included in the calculation of the expense or costs which shall be charged to and paid by the owner or occupant as provided in the village fee schedule in section 18-1. If the Village must hire an outside company to provide the necessary services to abate the nuisance, then all expenses or costs associated with their service shall be charged to and paid by the owner, or occupant.

SECTION 4. In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Ordinance that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clauses.


<u>SECTION 5.</u> That all ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

**SECTION 6.** That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 7. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
