AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTERS 18 (FEES AND OTHER CHARGES), SECTION 18-1 (FEES) OF THE BRADLEY VILLAGE CODE (Emergency ambulance and fire service fees)

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have the authority to "operate ambulances as a municipal service" and to "make reasonable charges therefor" pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-5-7; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have previously exercised the authority granted by 65 ILCS 5/11-5-7, establishing the type of services provided and fees charged for ambulance services within the Village; and

WHEREAS, Section 18-1 sets forth the fees for emergency ambulance and fire services provided in Section 20-65 of the Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 20-65 of the Village Code, the ambulance and mileage fees set forth in Section 18-1 of this Code shall be increased annually pursuant to the applicable Medicare reimbursement rate or three percent, whichever is greater; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is necessary and in the best interests of the Village and its citizens to amend the fees charged for emergency ambulance and fire services as contained Section 18-1 of the Village Code as more fully set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The President and Board of Trustees hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. Chapter 18 (Fees and other charges), Section 18-1 (Fees) is hereby amended in part, as follows:



SECTION 5. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 6. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
