AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LIQUOR LICENSE FEES FOR THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 235 ILCS 5/1-1 et seq., the Illinois Liquor Control Act (the "Act"), the Corporate Authorities of the Village have the power to determine the number, kind, and classification of licenses for sale at retail of alcoholic liquor; the amount of local licensee fees to be paid for the each of the various classes of licenses to be issued; and to establish such further regulations and restrictions upon the issuance of and operation under such local liquor licenses as the public health, safety, welfare, and convenience may require; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have previously adopted ordinances that regulate the licensing, sale and service of alcoholic beverages within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the Village to amend the provisions of Chapter 4 (Alcoholic Beverages) of the Bradley Village Code of Ordinances as set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> Chapter 4 (Alcoholic Beverages), Article III (Licenses), Division 1 (In General), Section 4-77 (Number of Licenses, Annual License Fees, and Automatic License Reduction) is hereby amended, in part, to read as follows:

(a) The number of license in each classification, as well as the annual fee for said license, shall be as follows:

SECTION 4. That all ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 5. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

<u>SECTION 6.</u> That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
