**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LIQUOR LICENSE FEES FOR THE VILLAGE OF
BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 235 ILCS 5/1-1 *et seq.*, the Illinois Liquor Control Act (the "Act"), the Corporate Authorities of the Village have the power to determine the number, kind, and classification of licenses for sale at retail of alcoholic liquor; the amount of local licensee fees to be paid for the each of the various classes of licenses to be issued; and to establish such further regulations and restrictions upon the issuance of and operation under such local liquor licenses as the public health, safety, welfare, and convenience may require; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have previously adopted ordinances that regulate the licensing, sale and service of alcoholic beverages within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the Village to amend the provisions of Chapter 4 (Alcoholic Beverages) of the Bradley Village Code of Ordinances as set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CORPORATE AUTHORITIES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PURSUANT TO ITS STATUTORY AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are true, correct, and complete and are hereby incorporated by reference hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. Chapter 4 (Alcoholic Beverages), Article III (Licenses), Division 1 (In General), Section 4-77 (Number of Licenses, Annual License Fees, and Automatic License Reduction) is hereby amended, in part, to read as follows:

- (a) The number of license in each classification, as well as the annual fee for said license, shall be as follows:

Class A2 license (Restaurant with Service Bar Only - Full Liquor & Entertainment).	2	\$ 1,200.00

Class A4 license (Restaurant with Age-Restricted Lounge and Package Sales).	1	\$ 1,200.00

Class C3 license (Liquor Store).	3	\$ 1,500.00
Class D1 license (Non-Profit Organization).	1	\$ 1,200.00
Class E1 license (Golf Courses).	1	\$ 1,200.00
Class F1 license (Special Events).	As requested	\$ 250.00
Class G1 license (Hotel or Motel with Restaurant, Patron Bar and/or Package Sales).	5	\$ 1,200.00
Class H1 license (Escape Room).	1	\$ 1,200.00
Class I1 license (Video Gaming Café).	5	\$ 2,500.00
Class J1 license (Off-Site Catering add-on).	As requested	\$ 200.00

SECTION 3. In the event that any provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses of this Ordinance shall be declared to be invalid or unenforceable by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such adjudication shall in no way affect or impair the validity or enforceability of any of the remaining provisions, portions, or clauses of this Ordinance that may be given effect without such invalid or unenforceable provision or provisions, portion or portions, or clause or clauses.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, conflicting with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 5. That the Village Clerk is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

SECTION 6. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
