# AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village of Bradley ("Village"), it is no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of the Village, to retain the property described in Section 2 below; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Village to expeditiously dispose of the property set forth in Section 2 pursuant to the authority granted to the Village by the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 (2011).

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED** by the President and the Trustees of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois:

- <u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals Incorporated.</u> The above recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance and shall have the same force and effect as though fully set forth herein.
- Section 2. Property No Longer Useful to the Village. Pursuant to section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, and 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village finds that continued ownership of the following items are no longer necessary or useful to the Village or for the best interests of the Village to retain ownership:
  - Thirteen (13) Safety Vision, Model SV-4CHDDVR, In-Car Camera Systems;
  - Fuji, 26", Blue Mountain Bike, Serial#1F9C0539 (In-disrepair);
  - Cannondale, 26" Black Mountain Bike, Serial# 0911485M20; (In-disrepair)
  - Misc. used vehicle equipment, i.e., prisoner partitions and emergency equipment.
- <u>Section 3.</u> <u>Disposal of Property.</u> The items set forth in Section 2 above shall be disposed of by the Village of Bradley Chief of Police in the manner most beneficial to the Village of Bradley and in accordance with local ordinances and/or state statutes governing same, and upon execution of a Bill of Sale attached hereto where applicable.
- <u>Section 4.</u> <u>Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances.</u> If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance. All existing ordinances of the Village of Bradley are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.
- Section 5. Effective Date. The Clerk of the Village of Bradley shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause it to be published in pamphlet form and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and publication in pamphlet form as so certified.
