AN ORDINANCE CALLING FOR A REFERENDUM TO IMPLEMENT NON-HOME RULE RETAILERS' OCCUPATION TAX, NON-HOME RULE MUNICIPAL SERVICE OCCUPATION TAX AND NON-HOME RULE MUNICIPAL USE TAX FOR EXPENDITURE FOR PROPERTY TAX RELIEF OR FOR EXPENDITURE ON PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE OR BOTH, AS WELL AS FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUPPORTING MUNICIPAL OPERATIONS

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois, (the "Village") deem it advisable, necessary and in the best interest of the Village that the proposition therefore, be submitted to the voters of the Village at an Election to be held and conducted with the general law:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY, KANKAKEE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Election</u>. That the proposition described in Section 6 herein shall be submitted to the voters of the Village in accordance with the general election law at the general primary election to be held on <u>Tuesday</u>, the <u>17th</u> day of <u>March</u>, 2020, between the hours provided by law for voting on such day (the "Election").

Section 2. <u>Election Precincts.</u> That the Election shall be held in the voting precincts and at the polling places established by the County Board (the "County Board") of Kankakee County, Illinois ("County") for voters of the Village.

Section 3. <u>Notices.</u> That the County Clerk of the County (the "County Clerk") shall give notice of the Election in accordance with the general election law by publishing notice thereof once in one or more local community newspapers published in and having general circulation in the Village, the dates of such publications of such notices to be not more than 30 nor less than 10 days prior to the date set for the Election. The ballot shall also be published as required by the Election Code.

Section 4. <u>Newspaper</u>. That it is hereby found and determined that the *Kankakee Daily Journal*, Kankakee, Illinois, is a local, community newspaper in Kankakee County and having general circulation in the Village under Sections 12-4 and 12-5 of the Election Code of the State of Illinois, as amended (the "Election Code").

Section 5. <u>Form of Notice</u>. That the notice of Election shall, subject to any modification necessary to comply with the Election Code, include the following:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at the general primary Election to be held on the 17th day of March, 2020, the following proposition will be submitted to the voters of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois:

"Shall the Village of Bradley, for the purpose of granting property tax relief or for expenditure on public infrastructure or both, as well as for the purpose of supporting municipal operations, impose a Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailer's Occupation Tax, Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax and Non-Home Rule Municipal Use Tax (commonly referred to as "Municipal Sales Taxes") each at a rate of 1% in accordance with and subject to provisions of Sections 8-11-1.3, 8-11-1.4 and 8-11-1.5 of the Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.3, 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.4 and 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.5)"

The polls at such Election will be open at 6:00 a.m. and continue to be open until 7:00 p.m. of that day.

Section 6. <u>Election</u>. That the ballot to be used at the Election shall be in substantially the following form, with such alterations, changes, and insertions and deletions as may be required by Article 24A of the Election Code if an electronic, mechanical or electrical voting system is used at the Election.

That, if an Electronic Voting System is used in the County, the County Clerk shall publish, not less than five (5) days prior to the Election, a true and legible copy of the specimen ballot label containing the question to be voted upon at the Election in two or more newspapers published in and having general circulation in the County.

Section 8. <u>Judges.</u> That the Election shall be conducted by the Election Judges appointed by the County Board to act in the precincts at which such proposition will be submitted to the voters of the Village of the County.

Section 9. <u>Certification to County Clerk.</u> That after the adoption hereof and not less than 79 days prior to the date of the Election, the Village Clerk shall certify a copy hereof to the County Clerk in order that the proposition set forth herein may be submitted to the voters of the Village at the Election.

Section 10. <u>Canvass.</u> That the Election shall be held and conducted and the returns thereof duly canvassed, all in the manner and time as provided by the general election law.

Section 11. <u>Conflict.</u> That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby superseded, that this ordinance be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption and that this ordinance shall be deemed to be subject to modification in application to comply with the general election law.
