AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village of Bradley ("Village"), it is no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of the Village, to retain the property described in Section 2 below; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Village to expeditiously dispose of the property set forth in Section 2 pursuant to the authority granted to the Village by the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 (2011).

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the President and the Trustees of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois:

<u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals Incorporated.</u> The above recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance and shall have the same force and effect as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Vehicles No Longer Useful to the Village. Pursuant to section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village finds that continued ownership of the following vehicles of the Village of Bradley are no longer necessary or useful to the Village or for the best interests of the Village to retain ownership:

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> The Clerk of the Village of Bradley shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause it to be published in pamphlet form and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and publication in pamphlet form as so certified.


