ORDINANCE NO. O-1-16-5

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSAL OF SURPLUS PROPERTY OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF BRADLEY

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village of Bradley ("Village"), it is no longer necessary or useful to, or in the best interests of the Village to, retain the property described in Section 2 below; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Village to expeditiously dispose of the property set forth in Section 2 pursuant to the authority granted to the Village by the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 (2011).

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the President and the Trustees of the Village of Bradley, Kankakee County, Illinois:

- <u>Section 1.</u> <u>Recitals Incorporated.</u> The above recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance and shall have the same force and effect as though fully set forth herein.
- Section 2. Vehicles and Gear No Longer Useful to the Village. Pursuant to section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the Village finds that continued ownership of the following vehicles and gear of the Village of Bradley Fire Department are no longer necessary or useful to the Village or in the best interests of the Village to retain ownership:
 - 1997 Chevy Suburban, VIN# 1GNGC26R3VJ390916, mileage: 78,502;
 - 1999 Chevy Astrovan, VIN# 1GNDM19W5XB125357, mileage: 60,364;
 - Fire Gear: 19 bunker coats, 23 bunker pants, 20 uniform coats, 9 uniform pants, 31 shirts;
 - Altair 4 CO monitor (serial no. 00030059).
- Section 3. Disposal of Property. The items set forth in Section 2 above shall be disposed of by the Village of Bradley Fire Chief in the manner most beneficial to the Village of Bradley and in accordance with local ordinances and/or state statutes governing same. A bill of sale shall be executed for the aforesaid vehicles, as attached. Funds received from the sale of the aforesaid vehicles shall be used toward the purchase of a 2016 GMC pickup truck by the Village of Bradley Fire Department.
- <u>Section 4.</u> <u>Severability and Repeal of Inconsistent Ordinances.</u> If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance. All existing ordinances of the Village of Bradley are hereby repealed insofar as they may be inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> The Clerk of the Village of Bradley shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause it to be published in pamphlet form and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and publication in pamphlet form as so certified.
